

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORK

October 20, 2011

The Board of Public Works and Safety met in a regular meeting on October 20, 2011 in the Mayor's office at 301 E Clinton Street, Frankfort, Indiana at 9:00 AM., the following action was taken.

Mayor Chris Pippenger called the meeting to order and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Jim Osbon, Jeff Danner, Bob Plass, Les Bergum, and Judy Suter were present.
