ORDINANCE NO. 09-12A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES AND FEES
FOR TRASH COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF
GARBAGE AND WASTE

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Frankfort has heretofore adopted Ordinance No. 04-29 entitled An Ordinance Reestablishing Procedures and Fees for Trash Collection and the Disposal of Garbage and Waste Materials for the City of Frankfort, Indiana, which ordinance was codified as Chapter 98 of the Code of the City of Frankfort, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, paragraph (f) of §98.02 of said Municipal Code was subsequently amended and restated by Ordinance No. 07-17; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Frankfort now desires to further amend and restate certain provisions of the City's trash ordinance under Chapter 98 of the Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that paragraph (1) of §98.03 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended and restated in its entirety to provide as follows:

(1) The City of Frankfort, acting through the Frankfort Street Department, shall provide a curbside or roadside trash collection service to only those residences located within the City of Frankfort comprising three or less residential units per building. Regular trash collection services shall be provided no less than one time per week for the collection of authorized trash bags. The times and

locations of the collection services shall be determined and established by the city of Frankfort Board of Public Works and Safety. If the scheduled trash pick-up for any residence is two (2) days during any week, then such residence shall be limited to five (5) bags per pick-up. If the scheduled trash pick-up for any residence is only one (1) day during any week, then such residence shall be limited to ten (10) bags per pick-up.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that paragraph (2) of §98.04 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended and restated in its entirety to provide as follows:

(2) Fees.

(a) A user fee of \$7.00 per month shall be added to the utility billing of each resident served and the assessment shall be applied to the costs of the City for the available service. In the case of residential complexes which cannot accommodate a dumpster, the user fee shall be \$12.00 per month per residential unit, as provided in §98.02 (f). In the event that any trash user fee remains unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, the City may suspend trash pick-up service to the residence involved, without notice. In such event, the owner or occupant of the residence shall promptly dispose of the trash attributed to said residence by private means.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of the date of its enactment.
